Recognizing Outstanding Contributions to the Collaborative for Accountability & Improvement and CRP Field

Purpose

The Collaborative for Accountability and Improvement's (CAI) work is supported by a number of stakeholders, experts, and advocates who volunteer their time and skills to move the field of Communication and Resolution Programs (CRPs) forward. CAI has created an award to recognize an individual who has contributed significantly to the field, including but not limited to their work with CAI. This award may be appropriate when an individual is retiring or stepping down from their involvement with CAI, but can be given at any point in an individual's career.

Process

- To nominate someone, submit a complete CV or resume of the nominee along with a description of their contributions to the field (no more that one page) to thecai@uw.edu
- An ad hoc committee assembled by the Executive Director of the CAI and the Board President will review all nominations, focusing on the nominee's body of work in the CRP field
- The award will be given no more than once a year

Award

- This prestigious award will include the following:
 - An engraved plaque
 - A spotlight in the CAI newsletter, including an interview with the recipient
 - An invitation to present a webinar to the community about their work
